Tourism Promotion Authority Act 1993

REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD

I, Honourable Sir Pita Lus, Kt, OBE, Minister for Culture and Tourism, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9 of the *Tourism Promotion Authority Act* 1993 and all other powers me enabling, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby—

 - (iii) Michael Buleau, to represent airline industry and our national airline under Section 9(1)(d)(iii) of the *Tourism Promotion Authority Act* 1993 to be a member of the Tourism Promotion Authority Board;
 - (iv) Aho Baliki, to represent bank/financial institutions under Section 9(1)(d)(iv) of the *Tourism Promotion Authority Act* 1993 to be a member of the Tourism Promotion Authority Board;
 - (v) Max Benjamin, to represent dive industry under Section 9(1)(d)(vii) of the Tourism Promotion Authority Act 1993 to be a member of the Tourism Promotion Authority Board;
 - (vi) Betty Higgins, to represent guesthouses and tourism attraction industry under Section 9(1)(d)(v) of the *Tourism Promotion Authority Act* 1993 to be a member of the Tourism Promotion Authority Board; and
 - (vii) Michael Yaipupu. as experienced in culture and tourism development under Section 9(1)(e) of the Tourism Promotion Authority Act 1993 to be a member of the Tourism Promotion Authority Board;

for a period of two years commencing on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.
