Industrial Relations Act (Chapter No. 174)

AWARD No. 04 Of 2001

I, Lorraine Lambulai Morlin, Industrial Registrar, by virtue of the powers conferred by the *Industrial Relations Act* (Chapter No. 174), and all other powers me enabling, hereby register an Industrial Award described in the Schedule hereto under the title "Papua New Guinea Banking Corporation National Staff Association Award (No. 04 of 2001) and advise that copies of this Award may be obtained from the Industrial Registry, Department of Labour and Employment, P.O. Box 5644, Boroko, National Capital District.

SCHEDULE

A memorandum of Understanding made on the 20th June, 2001, between Papua New Guinea Banking Corporation, (hereinafter referred to as "the employer") of the one part and Papua New Guinea Banking Corporation National Staff Association (hereinafter referred to as "the union") of the other part whereby the parties agreed on the following matters;

1. That the suspension of members of the PNGBC National Staff Association Executives (President, Senior Vice President and Executive Secretary) effective from 13th June, 2001 is unconditionally lifted.
2. That all employees including officials of the PNGBCNSA nationwide who took part in stop work meetings since 13th June, 2001, shall not be penalised in any way whatsoever.
3. That all Employees shall return to work at 8.00 a.m. effective from 20th June 2001, as normal.
4. That all meetings or negotiations over the current disputed matters shall be conducted under the supervision and chairmanship of the Department of Labour and Employment.
5. That the Executive Chairman of PNGBC shall not take part in any meetings/negotiations with the Unions on the current disputed matters.
6. The parties agree to settle the current industrial dispute prior to the sale of PNGBC proceeding.

This agreement forms the basis for negotiations to commence immediately on all disputed matters.
