**SCHEDULE**

A Memorandum of Understanding made on the 19th September, 2002 between Ok Tedi Mining Limited, hereinafter referred to as "the employer") of one part and Ok Tedi Mining and Allied Workers Union (hereinafter referred to as "the Union") of the other part whereby the parties agreed:—

1. That this restructure (25th February - 29th August, 2002) and the subsequent redundancy exercise was concluded on 29th August, 2002.
2. That the redundant employees who opted for possible redeployment will be considered for redeployment as per the functions of the Redundancy Monitoring Committee (RMC).
3. That the line management shall in consultation with the Redundancy Monitoring Committee (RMC) shall make every effort to redeploy all affected employees who opted for redeployment using a matrix (matching skills with job vacancies) in accordance with clause six (6).
4. That prior to any vacant or new position being advertised or an appointment to any currently advertised position being made and that position could be filled by those persons referred to in item two (2) of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), reference must be made to the Redundancy Monitoring Committee (RMC) for review against the redundancy listing.
5. That the Redundancy Monitoring Committee (RMC) will deal with all matters emanating from this redundancy exercise according to the provisions of the consolidated Agreement of 1995 and 2000 and any other exercise of this nature in the future, until such time this Agreement is superseded by another.
6. That the Redundancy Monitoring Committee (RMC) shall have the powers to enforce compliance with all the necessary provisions consistent with the requirements stipulated in the 1995 and 2000 Agreements.
7. That the employees who participated in Home Ownership Scheme (HOS) and who are affected by this redundancy exercise will be forgiven outstanding (HOS) monies owing to the company using the revised forgiveness matrix as follows:—

Years of Continuous Service	2-but less than 6 years	6-but less than 10 years	10 plus years
Forgiven percentage	40%	70%	100%

The matrix above now supercedes the existing matrix referred to in the HOS Policy and Procedure and now applies to all employees affected by this current redundancy exercise referred to in this memorandum of understanding (MOU) items one (1) above, and will also apply to all future exists under medical, redundancies, retrenchment and death.

8. That those redundant employees who opted for redeployment and who had an "end of notice period" dated of 1st October, 2002 will now be extended by one (1) month to 1st November, 2002.
