Aid Status (Privileges and Immunities) Act (Chapter 345)

GRANT OF DESIGNATED AID STATUS

I, Silas Atopare, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 2(1) of the *Aid Status (Privileges and Immunities) Act (Chapter 345)*, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby grant of designated aid status to Australian Volunteers International on exemption on certain privileges and immunities offered by the Government of Papua New Guinea to aid agencies and volunteer organizations, exempt from taxation on salaries, import duties and levies on certain goods, waiving of immigration and visa restrictions.
