*National Road Safety Council Act 1997***OPERATIONAL INSTRUCTIONS**

I, Michael Mayberry, Chairman, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 45 of the *National Road Safety Council Act 1997*, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with the advice of the Executive Director for the National Road Safety Council Services, hereby fix the date of Festive Season Road Safety Campaigns (nick-named "Arrive Alive") as the date of gazettal notice on which the random safety road blocks by the NRSC and the Royal PNG Police Constabulary will come into operation throughout the country.

Any person or agency obstructing these operations or undertaking such operations without the approval of the National Road Safety Council will be in breach of the *NRSC Act* and liable for a fine of K2,000.00. Henceforth, issuing of Traffic Infringement Notices (TIN) without the NRSC's authorization will face likely prosecution under the *Finance Management Act*. Only NRSC has been authorized by the Secretary of the Department of Finance to collect TIN fines for the purposes of Road Safety Campaigns as stipulated in Section 31(e), (f) and (g) of the *NRSC Act*.
