Small Business Development Corporation Act 1990

REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS AND ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION BOARD

I, Silas Atopare, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 9 and 10 of the *Small Business Development Corporation Act 1990*, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after considering a recommendation from the Minister for Trade and Industry, hereby:—

(a) revoke the appointment of:—

- (ii) each person specified in Column 3 of Schedule 2 as Alternate Member of the Board for the Member opposite his name,

for a period of two years with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.

Organic Law on Provincial Governments and Local-level Governments

Public Services (Management) Act 1995

REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF ACTING PROVINCIAL ADMINISTRATOR

- (b) appoint Warren Temokang as Acting Provincial Administrator of the Southern Highlands Province until further notice,
