*Customs Act (Chapter 101)*

**APPOINTMENT OF NAPA NAPA SUFFERANCE WHARF**

I, David Sode, Commissioner-General of the Internal Revenue Commission, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by Section 8 of the *Customs Act* (Chapter 101) and all other powers me enabling, hereby appoint Inter Oil Refinery Napa Napa Wharf, located within the boundary of the declared Port of Port Moresby as specified in Schedule 1 and situated at latitude 9 degrees 27.5 minutes south, longitude 147 degrees 7 minutes east to be a Sufferance Wharf and it shall be used in accordance with the conditions as stipulated in Schedule 2 below.

This Appointment shall remain in force until such time it is revoked by a subsequent notice in the *National Gazette*.

**SCHEDULE 1**

All that piece or parcel of water actuate in the National Capital District and the Central Province commencing at a point on the high water mark on the southern most point of South Lolotau Island and bounded on the west generally north by the line of the high mark on the eastern foreshore of the south Lalarua Island, Northern Lolorau Island, Hanudarava Island and the main Land to Idumava Point, thence on the south again on the west and on the north generally westerly, northerly and easterly by the line of the high sea mark along the foreshore of the Fairfax Harbour to a point at the high water mark on the south eastern extremity of Coglun Head thence on the east and on the south east generally south easterly and south west by the line of the high water mark to Bogirohodobi Point thence again on the north and again on the east generally east and south east along the line of the high water mark to the south western extremity of the land of the Vabukori thence on the south east by straight line bearing 306 degrees from the high water mark at the said south western extremity of the land at Vabukori to the high water mark on the southern extremity of Manubada Island thence on the south by straight line bearing 245 degrees for approximately 5420 meters to the Basilisk Beacon thence again on the east generally southerly along the western limit of Nateara Reef to appoint at the extreme south west of the said Nateara Reef thence on the south west by straight line bearing 300 degrees to a point at the southern extremity of Sinavi Reef thence again on the south generally eastward along the south limit of Sinavi Reef to a point where the parallel 9 degrees 32 minutes 3 seconds cuts the eastern limit of the said Sinavi Reef for approximately 442 meters to a point at the north eastern extremity of the said Sinavi Reef thence again on the west by straight line 330 degrees to the point of commencement.

This Sufferance Wharf is to be used exclusively for the entry and examination of oil tankers carrying:—

- (a) crude oil transported from the Kumul Terminal or from an overseas destination,
- (b) refined petroleum products for export,
- (c) refined petroleum products for coastwise delivery,

And includes facilitating the entry and examination of:—

- (d) overseas vessels requesting bunkers, and
- (e) fishing vessels entering this Sufferance Wharf to obtain diesel fuel under the Customs Diesel Fuel Rebate Policy.

and comply with all provisions of the *Customs Act* (Chapter 101) and *Excise Act* (Chapter 105) and procedure guidelines drafted specifically for the operation at the Refinery.
