**“THE CONSTITUTION**

**TO: THE SPEAKER OF THE NATIONAL PARLIAMENT**

**GREETINGS!**

WHEREAS the Constitution of Papua New Guinea, by Section 249, provides amongst other things, that every Member of the National Parliament shall, before entering upon the duties of or exercising any of the powers of his Office make the Declaration of Office and the Declaration of Loyalty before a person appointed for the purposes by the Head of State in the forms set out in Schedule 3 and Section 6 respectively of the Constitution;

Now therefore, I, Sir Mari Kapi, CBE, Kt, CSI, Acting Governor-General, hereby appoint you to administer, from time to time, the declarations to those Members who have not already made their Declarations since their election to the National Parliament”.

## **REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT OF PROVINCIAL ADMINISTRATOR AND APPOINTMENT OF PROVINCIAL ADMINISTRATOR.**

THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, by virtue of the powers conferred by:—

- (a) Section 73(2B) of the *Organic Law on Provincial Governments and Local-Level Governments* and Section 60B of the *Public Services (Management) Act 1995*, and all other powers it enabling, hereby revoke the appointment of Simon Pentanu (who has resigned) as Provincial Administrator for Bougainville dated 3rd April, 2002 and published in *National Gazette* No. G.54 of 3rd April, 2002; and
- (b) Section 73(2) of the *Organic Law on Provincial Governments and Local-Level Governments* and Section 60 of the *Public Services (Management) Act 1995*, and all other powers it enabling, after considering a list comprising the names of three persons submitted by the Minister for Public Service after consultation with the Public Services Commission, hereby appoint Peter Tsiamalili as Provincial Administrator for Bougainville for a period of four years,

with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.
