## CONSTITUTION

### AMENDMENT OF DETERMINATION OF TITLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTERS

I, Michael Thomas Somare, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 148 of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, hereby amend the Determination of Titles and Responsibilities of Ministers dated 29th August, 2002 and published in *National Gazette* No. G138 of 29th August, 2002, as amended:—

(a) in Schedule 21 (Minister for Lands and Physical Planning) in Column 1—

(i) by deleting “Patrick Pruaitch” and inserting “Puka Temu”; and

(ii) in Column 3 by adding the following new Paragraph:—

“(f) the National Committee co-ordinating the national-wide appeal for the Tsunami disaster in the countries in South and South-East Asia.”; and

(b) in Schedule 23 (Minister for National Planning and Monitoring) in Column 1 by deleting “Sir Moi Avei” and inserting “Arthur Somare”,

with effect on and from the date of signature of this instrument.
