### *Organic Law on Certain Constitutional Office-holders*

#### **REVOCATION OF ACTING APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF AUDITOR-GENERAL**

I, Paulias Matane, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 213 of the Constitution and Section 13 of the *Organic Law on Certain Constitutional Office-holders* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after receiving reports from the Public Services Commission and the Public Accounts Committee, hereby:

- (a) revoke the appointment of Mac Pona Kawa as Acting Auditor-General as published in the *National Gazette* No. G136 of 16th October, 2003; and
- (b) appoint George Wasi Sulliman as Auditor-General for a period of six years, with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.
