*Excise Tariff Act (Chapter 107)*

## EXEMPTION FROM EXCISE DUTY

I, Paulias Matane, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3(1)(a) of the *Excise Tariff Act* (Chapter 107), and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby exempt from excise duty on motor vehicles and other goods directly purchased or contributed towards the Papua New Guinea 30th Independence Anniversary, the hosting of the Pacific Islands Forum (PIF) and the Melanesian Spearhead Group (MSG) Summit between the period commencing on and from 1st January, 2005 up to and including 31st October, 2005.

## REVOCATION OF ACTING APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF DEPARTMENTAL HEAD
