Public Services (Management) Act 1995

REVOCATION OF ACTING APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF DEPARTMENTAL HEAD

I, Grand Chief Sir Paulias Matane, GCL., G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 193(1A) of the Constitution, and Section 31A and 31B of the *Public Services (Management) Act 1995*, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council:—

- (a) given in accordance with a recommendation by the Public Services Commission, hereby revoke the appointment of Dr. Joseph Pagelio as Acting Secretary for the Department of Education; and
- (b) from a list of persons recommended by the Public Service Commission, hereby appoint Dr. Joseph Pagelio to be the Secretary for the Department of Education, for a period of four years,
