PUBLIC HOLIDAY

I, Grand Chief Sir Paulias Matane, G.C.L., G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the *Public Holidays Act* (Chapter 321), and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby appoint Thursday 20th April, 2006 to be a public holiday throughout the Oro Province.

Public Holidays Act (Chapter 321)

PUBLIC HOLIDAY

I, Grand Chief Sir Paulias Matane, G.C.L., G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 1 of the *Public Holidays Act* (Chapter 321), and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby:—

- (a) revoke the appointment Tuesday 25th April, 2006 as Remembrance Day (Public Holiday) as published in the *National Gazette* No. G104 of 21st July, 2005; and
- (b) revoke the appointment of Sunday 2nd July, 2006 as the day to Commemorate the PNG Remembrance Day (Public Holiday) as published in the *National Gazette* No. G104 of 21st July, 2005; and
- (c) appoint 23rd July, 2006 to be Remembrance Day and Public Holiday throughout the Country; and
- (d) appoint Monday 24th July, 2006 to be Public Holiday throughout the Country.
