Cemeteries Act (Chapter 302)

LICENSING FOR PRIVATE BURIAL GROUND

I, Sir Peter Barter, Minister for Provincial and Local Government Affairs, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the *Cemeteries Act* (Chapter 302), and all other powers me enabling, hereby license the State to use the land described in Schedule 1 hereto ("the cemetery") for burials subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 2 hereto.

SCHEDULE 1

All that piece or parcel of land referred to as Independence Hill in the National Capital District and more particularly described as Allotment 19, Section 374, Hohola, City of Port Moresby, National Capital District.

SCHEDULE 2

Conditions pertaining to the Licence

- 1. The cemetery shall be for the burial of persons who have occupied the Office of Prime Minister of Papua New Guinea.
- 2. Each Allotment in which a body is buried shall be marked with the name and date of death of the person buried there.
- 3. A burial only take place in accordance with the requisites for burial as set out in Section 21 of the Cemeteries Act (Chapter 302).
- 4. Notice shall be given to the Registration Officer of every person buried in the cemetery.
- 5. The Department of the Prime Minister and National Executive Council shall maintain a plan of the cemetery and a record of the date of each burial and of the name of the person buried.
