## CONSTITUTION

### RECOMMITTAL OF A LAW TO PARLIAMENT

I, Grand Chief Sir Paulias Matane, G.C.L., G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 110(3) of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby direct that the Constitutional Amendment (Provincial Electorates) Law 2006 passed by the Parliament on the 14th November, 2006 but not yet certified by the Speaker be recommitted to the National Parliament for consideration of the following amendment which I proposed as the Head of the State, acting with and in accordance with the advice of the National Executive Council:—

“Made by the National Parliament to come into operation in accordance with a notice in the *National Gazette* by the Head of State, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the Minister”.
