Coffee Industry Corporation (Statutory Powers and Functions) Act 1991

DECLARATION OF RESTRICTED AREAS AND RESTRICTION ON THE SALE AND PURCHASE OF COFFEE CHERRY

I, Pugma Kopi, Chairman of the Coffee Industry Corporation Limited, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by Section 6(1)(c), 20, 21 and 22 of the Coffee Industry Corporation (Statutory Powers and Functions) Act 1991, repeal all previous notices relating to the dealing in cherry coffee and in its place hereby declare:—

- 1. that the five (5) provinces in the highlands namely Eastern Highlands, Western Highlands, Southern Highlands, Simbu and Enga be restricted areas with regard to the buying and selling of cherry coffee, except with the consent of the Coffee Industry Corporation Ltd.
- 2. that all private coffee buyers are prohibited from purchasing cherry coffee along the road sides, except with the consent of the Coffee Industry Corporation Ltd.
- 3. that all coffee growers are prohibited from selling cherry coffee along the road sides to any private coffee buyer, except with the consent of the Coffee Industry Corporation Ltd.
- 4. Cherry coffee dealing (selling & buying) are to be conducted only by operators of licensed wet processing factories or their contracted buyers certified by the Coffee Industry Corporation Ltd at the processing centre under specific requirements.
- 5. that the carriage or conveyance of cherry coffee in all the restricted areas is prohibited, except through Coffee Industry Corporation approved contractual arrangements by operations of licensed wet processing factories, or with the direct consent of the Coffee Industry Corporation Ltd.
- 6. that this declaration comes into from 1st January, 2008 and will remain for an indefinite period.
