NOTICE PURSUANT TO CLAUSE 1.4(ii) OF THE PNG HARBOURS REGULATORY CONTRACT ("CONTRACT")

I, Thomas Abe, Commissioner and CEO of the Independent Consumer & Competition Commission ("ICCC"), by virtue of the powers conferred to me by the *Independent Consumer & Competition Commission Act 2002* and Clause 1.4(ii) of the above Contract entered into between the ICCC and PNG Ports Corporation Limited ("PNG Ports") and all other powers enabling me, hereby approve the following tariffs as the approved tariffs to be applied by PNG Ports for its regulated essential port services for the 2009 regulatory year.

This notice amends and replaces the earlier notice published in the *National Gazette* No. G236 of 11th December, 2008.

4. TRANSHIPMENTS

The above tariffs shall come into effect on the 1st January, 2009.
