## CONSTITUTION

### EXERCISE OF POWERS OF THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 149 (4) of the Constitution and all other powers it enabling, hereby, with effect on and from 1st November, 2007:—

- (a) revoke the determination of the exercise of the powers of the National Executive Council dated 18th June, 2007, and published in the *National Gazette* No. G129 of 27th August, 2007; and
- (b) determine that the powers, functions, duties and responsibilities of the National Executive Council—
  - (i) to appoint Acting Provincial Administrators under Section 73(2A) of the *Organic Law on Provincial Governments and Local-Level Governments* and Section 60A of the *Public Services (Management) Act 1995*; and
  - (ii) in advising the Head of State to appoint Acting Departmental Heads and Acting Deemed Departmental Heads under Section 193(I) and (1B) of the Constitution and Section 31B of the *Public Services (Management) Act 1995*,

shall be exercised by the Minister for Public Service by instrument in the name of the National Executive Council; and

- (c) determine that Paragraph (b) does not extend to revocation and suspension of the Acting Provincial Administrators, Acting Departmental Heads and Acting Deemed Departmental Heads.
