Public Finances (Management) Act 1995

APPOINTMENT OF OFFICERS TO APPROVE REQUISITIONS OF EXPENDITURES

I, Hitelai D. Polume-Kiele, Acting Secretary, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 32 of the *Public Finances (Management) Act 1995* and all other powers enabling me, hereby:—

Revoke the Notice of Appointments of Officers to approve Requisitions published in the *National Gazette* No. G85 dated 31st May, 2007 in so far as it relates to Department of Justice and Attorney-General; and

Appoint each Officer specified in Column 1 of the following Schedule to approve Requisitions for expenditure of monies out of Recurrent and Development funding as specified in the Schedule.

Where the Schedule specifies an Officer against a specific Recurrent Budget Activity, that Officer is authorized to approve Requisitions for Expenditure for the purposes specified under the Program/Activity (Vote Code) for which they are responsible. The approval is not to exceed:—
