Industrial Relations Act (Chapter 174)

APPOINTMENT OF MINIMUM WAGES BOARD MEMBERS

I, Grand Chief Sir Paulias Matane, Governor-General, G.C.L., G.C.M.G., K.St.J., by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 10 of the *Industrial Relations Act* (Chapter 174) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby:—

- (a) appoint Bill Sharp Kua as member of the Minimum Wages Board to represent the Government; and
 - (b) appoint John Gordon Jeffrey and Allan Philip Maino as members of the Minimum Wages Board to represent the Employers' Federation of Papua New Guinea; and
 - (c) appoint Reginald McAlister and Clemence Kanau as members of the Minimum Wages Board to represent the PNG Maritime Workers' Union; and
 - (d) appoint Scholla Warai Kakas as member of the Minimum Wages Board to represent the community affairs; and
 - (e) appoint Bishop Oika Gabutu as member of the Minimum Wages Board to represent the Churches,
- with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.
