NOTICE PURSUANT TO CLAUSE 1.4(ii) OF THE PNG HARBOURS REGULATORY CONTRACT ("CONTRACT")

I, Thomas Abe, Commissioner & CEO of the Independent Consumer and Competition Commission ("ICCC"), by virtue of the powers conferred to me by the *Independent Consumer and Competition Commission Act 2002* and Clause 1.4(ii) of the above Contract entered into between the ICCC and PNG Ports Corporation Limited ("PNG Ports") and all other powers enabling me, hereby approve the following tariffs as the approved tariffs to be applied by PNG Ports for its regulated essential port services. These tariffs will apply from 1st January, 2010 until the new PNG Ports Regulatory Contract is issued in 2010 and the new tariffs within that Contract come into effect.

5. TRANSHIPMENTS

The tariffs for trans-shipments (both inward and outward) will be charged at half (50%) of the respective approved wharfage tariffs for the 2009 regulatory year in accordance with Schedule 1, Part A of the PNG Harbours Regulatory Contract.

The above tariffs shall come into effect on 1st January, 2010 and will apply until the PNG Ports Regulatory Contract is issued and the new tariffs within it come into effect.
