Employment of Non-citizens Act 2007

NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

I, Mark Maipakai, MP., Minister for Labour and Industrial Relations, in exercise of the powers conferred on me under Section 51(1) of the *Employment of Non-citizens Act 2007* do hereby exempt the following non-citizens from all of the requirements of the said Act.

In accordance with the requirement of Section 51(3) of the Act I hereby grant approval of these exemptions based on the project's significant contribution to the development of infrastructure in Papua New Guinea. The project funded by the Japanese Government is in the interest of the nation and for a good cause. The abovementioned non-citizens have been exempted from all of the requirements of foreigner work permits, dated from 1st January, 2010 to 1st January, 2012.

A specific condition placed against this exemption is that the company involved is required to provide training opportunities for human resource development and skills training to citizen workers in the specified jobs within the approved period.
