Broadcasting Corporation Act (Chapter 149)

APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN, DEPUTY CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL BROADCASTING CORPORATION BOARD

I, Sir Salamo Injia, Kt., Acting Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 193(2) of the Constitution and Sections 12 and 16 of the *Broadcasting Corporation Act (Chapter 149)* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consultation with the Public Services Commission and the Permanent Parliamentary Committee on appointments, hereby—

- (a) appoint Paul Raptario, Timothy Maisu, Moale Rivu, Theresea Jainton and Henao Iduhu to be members of the National Broadcasting Corporation Board for a period of three years; and
- (b) appoint Paul Raptario to be the Chairman and Timothy Maisu to be the Deputy Chairman of the National Broadcasting Corporation Board for a period of three years,

with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.
