Public Services (Management) Act 1995

- 1. ABOLISHMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ENTERPRISE AND THE OFFICE OF THE DEPARTMENTAL HEAD; and**
- 2. REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT OF SECRETARY FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ENTERPRISE**

I, Sir Michael Ogio, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 193(1C) of the Constitution and Sections 20(2)(b) and 22(2)(a) and 31C of the *Public Services (Management) Act 1995*, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consultation with the Public Services Commission, hereby:—

- (a) abolish the Department of Public Enterprise; and
- (b) abolish the Office of the Departmental Head of the Department of Public Enterprise; and
- (c) revoke the appointment of Mathias Lasia as Secretary for the Department of Public Enterprise as published in the *National Gazette* No. G14 of 20th January, 2011, with effect on and from 23rd November, 2011.
