McConnell Dowell Constructors (PNG) Limited a contracting company to the PNG LNG Project wishes to engage the services of experienced non-citizens who are required urgently in the Construction Phase of the LNG Project. The company is engaged in the construction of Komo Airfield in Southern Highlands and the LNG Main Plant Buildings at the Motukea Site, Port Moresby.

The exemptions granted in accordance to Section 51 of the *Employment of Non-citizens Act 2007* are always in the interest of the nation and for a good cause, in view of the Project's contribution to the country's development in terms of economic, human resource and infrastructure development.

The exemptions are granted from 12th December, 2011 to 12th December, 2012.

Specific conditions placed against the exemptions are:—

- (1) For the company to pay a fee of K1000.00 for each employee to the Department of Labour & Industrial Relations;
- (2) For the company to register all non-citizen employees that require registration with a professional body;
- (3) For the company to provide employment opportunities (decent work, fair pay, promotions etc) to citizen workers;
- (4) For the company to provide opportunities for human resource development and skills training to its employees; and
- (5) Non English speaking countries to show evidence of English proficiency for applicants.
