APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL AND LAW REFORM COMMISSION

I, Ano Pala, LLB, MP, Minister for Justice and Attorney-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 260 and Schedule 2.6.13 of the *Constitution*, and Section 3(3)(b), (c) and (d) of the *Constitution and Law Reform Commission Act 2004* and all other powers enabling, hereby appoint:
