### REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY COMMISSIONER OF POLICE

I, GRAND CHIEF SIR MICHAEL OGIO. GCL., G.C.M.G., K. St. J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 46, 47 and 49(1) and (2) of the *Police Act 1998* and Section 6 of the *Public Employment (Non-Citizens) Act (Chapter 342)* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby—

- (a) revoke the appointment of **Alan Scott** as Deputy Commissioner of Police (Reforms, Training and APEC) as published in the *National Gazette* No. G59 of 4th February, 2016; and
- (b) appoint **Alan Scott** to the rank of Deputy Commissioner of Police (Reforms, Training and APEC), for a period three (3) years,

with effect on and from the date of his swearing in as a Member of the Royal Papua New Guinea Constabulary.
