## CONSTITUTION

I, PETER O'NEILL, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 148 of the Constitution and all other powers enabling, hereby —

- (a) revoke the Determination of Titles and Responsibilities of Ministers dated 10th August, 2012 and published in the *National Gazette* No. G304 of 10th August, 2012 and all other subsequent Determinations; and
- (b) determine that each Minister set out in Column 1 of each Schedule shall have —
- (i) the title specified in Column 2; and
  - (ii) the responsibilities specified in Column 3; and
  - (iii) the responsibilities for administering the Acts (or parts of the Act) specified in Column 4, and set out opposite the name of the Minister,

to come into effect on and from the date of signature of this instrument.
