ORDER OF EXEMPTION

I, **Lave Michael**, Chief Inspector of Mines of Papua New Guinea, in the exercise of the powers conferred on me by the *Mining (Safety) Act 1977* and *Mining (Safety) Regulation Act 1935*, order that Production Support Vessel (PSV) of the Solwara 1 Project (ML 154) shall be exempted from the observance on the application of the Standards Association of Australia Wiring Rules until Mining Lease (ML) 154 expires, or surrendered, or is cancelled whichever of these events should occur first. The following conditions, but not limited to, apply to the exemption:

1. The mine management shall apply risk management principles to manage all residual risks to as low as reasonably possible.
2. The mine shall fully comply with the latest updated edition of the international Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) Standard No; 60092.
3. Only technically qualified and competent person(s) shall design, construct, commission, operate, maintain, install and decommission the electrical equipment and installations.
4. Mines Inspectorate shall be kept informed of any alteration, modification or change(s) made on the project.
