St. J.**, Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 193(1A) of the Constitution and Section 27 of the *Public Services (Management) Act 2014*, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, an in accordance with, the advice of the Minister for Public Service (a delegate of the National Executive Council), on the recommendation of the Ministerial Executive Appointments Committee, hereby —

- (a) revoke the appointment of **John Kali** as Secretary for the Department of Personnel Management, with effect on and from 9th March, 2018; and
