### Land Act 1996

#### REVOCATION OF FORFEITURE

I, OSWALD TOLOPA, Acting Secretary for Department of Lands & Physical Planning, by virtue of the powers conferred to me under Section 123(1) of the *Land Act* 1996 and all other powers me enabling, hereby revoke the forfeiture under Section 122 of the *Land Act* 1996 published in the *National Gazette* No. G123—12th October, 2000 with respect to the land described in the Schedule.

The main reason being that the National Court on 22nd June, 2017 made an Order to revoke the forfeiture of the State Lease described in the Schedule as the decision of the then delegate of the Minister for Lands and Physical Planning, Guau Zurenuoc to purportedly forfeit the land is null and void of no effect hence the forfeiture is hereby revoked.

All that piece or parcel of land known as Allotment 6, Section 1, Boroko, National Capital District being the whole of the land more particularly described in the State Lease Volume: 17 Folio: 223.
