## CONSTITUTION

### AMENDMENT TO THE DETERMINATION OF TITLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTERS

I, **JAMES MARAPE**, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 148 of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, hereby amend the Determination of Titles and Responsibilities of Ministers published in *National Gazette* No. G498 of 13th June, 2019 (as amended) —

- (a) in Schedule 5 (**MINISTER FOR FINANCE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT**) in Column 1 by deleting “Charles Abel” and substituting “Rainbo Païta”; and
- (b) in Schedule 7 Column 2 by repealing the words “Minister for Petroleum” and substituting “Minister for Petroleum and Energy”; and
- (c) in Schedule 11 (**MINISTER FOR COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY**) in Column 1 by deleting “Wera Mori” and substituting “William Duma”; and
- (d) in Schedule 14 (**MINISTER FOR COMMUNICATION AND ENERGY**) —
  - (i) in Column 1 by deleting “Rainbo Païta” and substituting “Timothy Masiu”; and
  - (ii) in Column 2 by deleting “Minister for Communication and Energy” and replacing it with “Minister for Communication and Information Technology”; and
- (e) in Schedule 15 (**MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND INTERNATIONAL TRADE**) in Column 1 by deleting “Soroi Eoe” and substituting “Patrick Pruaitch”; and
- (f) in Schedule 19 (**MINISTER FOR ENVIRONMENT, CONSERVATION AND CLIMATE CHANGE**) in Column 1 by deleting “Jeffery Kama” and substituting “Wera Mori”.
- (g) in Schedule 22 (**MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND HIV/AIDS**) in Column 1 by deleting “Elias Kapavore” and substituting “Jelta Wong”; and

- (h) in Schedule 25 (**MINISTER FOR IMMIGRATION AND BORDER SECURITY**) in Column 1 by deleting “Petrus Thomas” and substituting “Wesley Nukundj”; and
- (i) in Schedule 27 (**MINISTER FOR LABOUR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS**) in Column 1 by deleting “Alfred Manase” and substituting “Jeffery Kama”; and
- (j) in Schedule 31 (**MINISTER FOR PUBLIC SERVICE**) in Column 1 by deleting “Wesley Nukundj” and substituting “Soroi Eoe”.
