(Passed as House Bill No. 10-3-1, HD1, SD1)

AN ACT

To require all commercial wireless service providers in the Republic of Palau to produce and make readily available service coverage maps for consumers; to provide a penalty for noncompliance; and for other related purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF PALAU REPRESENTED IN THE OLBIIL ERA KELULAU DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Legislative findings.

The Olbiil Era Kelulau finds that wireless services are of increasing importance for the communication in the Republic of Palau and worldwide. They have become a replacement for traditional telephone service for many residents of the Republic of Palau. With the increasing use of wireless services by individuals and businesses, many consumers depend on a wireless provider's promise of coverage in a particular state or area of the Republic. A growing number of consumer complaints indicate that some wireless service providers are misrepresenting or not adequately disclosing their geographic coverage and that no service map with specific coverage data is readily available for consumers. As a result, many consumers only learn about the limited coverage after they have subscribed to a certain provider's services, which in some instances is not reversible. The Olbiil Era Kelulau seeks to protect the people of the Republic of Palau as consumers of wireless services. The Olbiil Era Kelulau therefore finds that each commercial wireless service provider must have an adequate service coverage map readily available for its consumers. Such map shall clearly indicate the areas which are covered by the specific wireless provider. The Olbiil Era Kelulau finds that with this Act, the people of the Republic can enter into informed agreements with wireless service providers, should they wish to do so.

Section 2. Establishment of Wireless Service Coverage Maps.

- (a) All commercial wireless service providers are required to generate a map of the geographic scope in which the provider is licensed and able to provide commercial wireless service in the Republic of Palau.
- (b) Each Wireless Service Coverage Map shall depict the outdoor service coverage area of the provider as well as any known outdoor service coverage gaps.

Section 3. Specificity Required.

- (a) Each commercial wireless service provider shall generate at least one coverage map as required under Section 2 of this Act using predictive modeling and mapping techniques commonly used by radio frequency engineers in the commercial wireless service industry to depict approximate outdoor service coverage based on signal strength for the applicable commercial wireless service technology and signal strength confidence levels under normal operating conditions on such provider's network.
 - (b) Variables that impact radio service generally shall be disclosed as material limitations in commercial wireless service depiction and availability.
 - (c) The coverage map generated under this section shall be updated at reasonable regular intervals and all updates shall be forwarded to the Ministry of Public Infrastructure, Industries and Commerce. The Ministry must publish the maps on its website within thirty (30) days of receipt.
 - (d) The coverage map generated under this section shall be in sufficient detail to identify:
 - General geographic areas where the wireless service provider offers full and reliable coverage;
 - (2) General geographic areas where the wireless service provider predicts that wireless service is not regularly available; and
 - (3) General geographic areas where the wireless service provider offers no coverage.
 - (e) The coverage map generated under this section shall be clear, easy to read and understand, and include color schemes for the areas set forth under subsection
 (d)(1)-(3) of this section.
 - (f) The coverage map must prominently display the month and year of the date that the map was completed.

Section 4. Disclosure to Consumers.

Each commercial wireless provider in the Republic of Palau shall provide a service coverage map as required by this Act:

- (a) to every consumer upon request of the consumer;
- (b) to any consumer who enters into a new wireless service plan; and
- (c) to existing customers.

Section 5. Online Access and Physical Display.

Each commercial wireless provider in the Republic of Palau shall make a service coverage map as required by this Act:

- (a) available on the provider's website;
- (b) publically displayed at any physical location where the service provider sells or promotes its services; and
 - (c) publically displayed at the main office or headquarters of the service provider.

Section 6. Penalty for noncompliance.

Any commercial wireless service provider that does not comply with the requirements in Sections 2 through 5 of this Act shall be guilty of a violation and shall pay a fine of \$100.00 per day the commercial wireless service provider is found to be out of compliance. The Ministry of Public Infrastructure, Industries and Commerce shall be responsible for determining the compliance of a commercial wireless service provider and any perceived violations shall be forwarded to the Attorney General to initiate action against the commercial wireless service provider.

Section 7. Regulations.

The Ministry of Public Infrastructure, Industries and Commerce shall promulgate rules and regulations in accordance with this Act within ninety (90) days of the effective date of this Act.

Section 8. <u>Effective date</u>. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the President of the Republic of Palau, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
