THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE) (GOVERNOR-GENERAL) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2006

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 3 of the Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) Act, the Minister hereby makes the following regulations -

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Governor-General) (Amendment) Regulations 2006, and shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 1st January, 2006.

2. Regulation 2 of the Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Governor-General) Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations") is hereby amended by deleting paragraph (1) and substituting therefor the following -

Amendment of regulation 2(1) of LN 140 of 1990

- (1) The Governor-General shall be paid a fortnightly salary of \$5,000.00.
- 3. Regulation 9(1) of the principal Regulation is hereby Amendment amended by deleting the words "forty dollars" and substituting therefor the words "three hundred dollars".
- 4. Regulation 10(1) of the principal Regulation is hereby Amendment deleted and the following new regulation substituted therefor of regulation 10
 - (1) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (2) the Governor General shall be entitled on official overseas travel to an allowance of US\$300.00 per day.
- 5. Regulation 12(1) of the principal Regulation is hereby Amendment amended by deleting the words "six thousand" and substituti- of regulation 12 tuting therefor the words "ten thousand".
- 6. The principal Regulation is hereby amended by inserting therein immediately after regulation 12 the following as regulation 12A Insertion of new regulation

"Education 12A. The Governor-General shall be entitled to an allowance annual education grant of \$5,000.00

7. Regulation 14(1) of the principal Regulation is hereby Amendment deleted and the following new regulation substituted thereof- of regulation 14

(1) The Governor - General shall be entitled to an annual clothing allowance of "fifteen thousand dollars".

Insertion of new regulation

- 8. The principal Regulation is hereby amended by inserting immediately after regulation 21 the following new regulation as regulation 22 -

22. The Governor - General shall be entitle to pension at the rate of 45% of his basic annual salary."
