EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2021

EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19)(EXCEPTION FOR ENTRY INTO SOLOMON ISLANDS) (NO. 159) ORDER 2021

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, Prime Minister, under regulation 7(3) of the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (No. 2) Regulations 2021* (Legal Notice No. 198 of 2021), and with reference to sections 36 and 65 of the *Interpretation and General Provisions Act* (Cap. 85), make the following Order:

1 Citation

This Order may be cited as the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19)(Exception for Entry into Solomon Islands)(No. 159) Order 2021*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day it is published in the *Gazette*.

3 Non-citizens who may enter Solomon Islands

Each of the persons specified in the Schedule may enter Solomon Islands on or about 7 October 2021 despite the prohibition under regulation 7(1) of the Regulations:

- (a) Justin Mark Anning;
- (b) Andrew Michael Dunn;
- (c) Bernard Rakocevic;
- (d) Joshua Pierre Raymond;
- (e) Mark Peter Farrer;
- (f) Benjamin Noel Yip;
- (g) Mark Richard Northcote.

4 Revocation

The *Emergency Powers (COVID-19)(Exception for Entry into Solomon Islands)(No. 149) Order 2021* (Legal Notice 235 of 2021) is revoked.
