THE EASTERN ISLANDS COUNCIL (VILLAGE HEALTH) BYE-LAWS 1976

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 50 of the Local Government Ordinance, the Eastern Islands Council, in pursuance of a resolution dated 19th day of August 1975 hereby makes the following bye-laws:—

Citation.

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Eastern Islands Council (Village Health) Bye-laws 1976.

Interpretation. 2. In these bye-laws "Council" means the Eastern Islands Council.

Defection on foreshore prohibited.

- 3. (1) No person shall defecate on the foreshore within the area of authority of the Council or in any place within the limits of any village school or clinic of Eastern Islands Council area other than a latrine approved by a medical officer.
- (2) Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bye-law shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of two dollars or in default of payment to imprisonment for seven days.
