AN ORDINANCE TO

Appropriate, Two Million and Three Hundred and Forty Seven Thousand, Nine Hundred and One Dollars to the service of the Fiscal Year ending 31 March 1997.

Enacted by the Makira Ulawa Province Assembly

THE MAKIRA ULAWA PROVINCE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 1996

1. This Ordinance shall be cited as the "Makira Ulawa Province Appropriation Ordinance 1996" and shall come into force upon Assert by the Minister in accordance with Section 32 of the Provincial Government Act 1981 and Publication in the Solomon Islands Gazette.

Short Title and Commence-

2. The appropriation from the Provincial Fund is hereby authorized of the Sum of Two Million and Three Hundred and Forty Seven Thousand, Nine Hundred and One Dollars to be applied for the purpose specified in sub-Section 36(2) of the Provincial Government Act, and to the Service of the Financial Year ending 31st March 1997.

Authoisation of Issurance of \$2,347,901.00 from the Provisional Fund.

3. The Sum specified in the preceding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the Heads specified and in the amounts respectively in relation thereto, in the schedule to this Ordinance.
