**TEMOTU PROVINCE APPROPRIATION (INTERIM EXPENDITURE)
ORDINANCE 2008**

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS ONLY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTINUING EXISTING TEMOTU PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES DURING THE PERIOD FROM 1 APRIL 2008 TO 31 JULY 2008.

ENACTED BY THE TEMOTU PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY

Article
1
Commencement

1. This ordinance shall be cited as the Temotu Province Appropriation (Interim Expenditure) Ordinance 2008 and shall come into force on 1 April 2008.

Justification of issuance
1,895,000.00 from
Provincial Fund

2. Subject to section 3, the appropriation from the Provincial Fund is hereby authorised of the sum of one million eight hundred and ninety-five thousand dollars only, to be applied for the purposes specified in section 34, subsection 2 of the Provincial Government Act 1997 (the "Act") and during the period commencing on 1 April 2008 and ending not later than 31 July 2008.

Expenditure to be
applied for
maintenance
of services

3. (1) The appropriation provided for in section 2 may be applied only in such amounts as is necessary for the maintenance of existing Temotu Provincial Government services; and until such time as an Appropriation Ordinance for the financial year ending on 31 March 2009 and that complies with clause 8(1)(a) of Schedule 2 of the Act (the "Appropriation Ordinance 2008/2009"), is in force.

(2) Other than section 4, this ordinance will lapse and cease to have effect at midnight on 31 July 2008 or on the date the Appropriation Ordinance 2008/2009 comes into force, whichever event occurs first.

Passed by the Temotu Provincial Assembly this 31st day of March 2008.
