(No. 22 of 1979)****ISABEL PROVINCE (TREE PRESERVATION)
BUALA ORDER 1993**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 27(1)(4) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1979, the Isabel Province Town and Country Planning Board hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Isabel (Tree Preservation) Buala Order 1993 and shall come into force on the date hereof and shall apply in respect of all the areas specified in the schedule.
2. In this Order "Board" means the Isabel Province Town and Country Planning Board.
3. The Board declares that it is expedient in the interests of amenity to preserve the trees in the areas specified in the schedule to this order.
4. No person shall cut down, top, lop or wilfully destroy any trees listed in the schedule to this Order, except with the prior written consent of the Board.
5. The Board may give consent subject to conditions including the condition of security to replant trees in such manner and such number and types of trees as the Board shall determine.
6. Application for consent should be made in writing addressed to the Secretary of the Board.
