THE "BARAVA TOP" BOTTLED WATER PRODUCT RECALL
 ORDER 1997

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Consumer
 Protection Act, 1995 the Minister hereby makes the following Order -

1. This Order may be cited as the "BARAVA TOP" Bottled
 Water Recall Order 1997.
2. Szetu Enterprises Limited of P.O. Box 45, Honiara,
 Solomon Islands, the producer of the product "BARAVA TOP" Bottled
 Water is hereby -
 - (a) prohibited from producing and distributing the
 above-named product unit further notice;

(b) ordered to disclose to the public through the media that the above-named product is not safe for human consumption and should be set aside for recollection by the company;

(c) ordered to recall all "BARAVA TOP" Bottled Water products which are distributed to all its customers and which ever persons which have the above-named product in their possession, custody, storage, control;

(d) ordered to recall ALL the above-named product before the thirteenth day of December 1996.

(e) ordered to do any other actions which it deems appropriate to facilitate the aforesaid orders and the purpose and intention of this whole Order.
