(Cap. 99)THE PORTS (DECLARATION OF PORT LIMITS)  
(PORT OF TETERE) ORDER 1997

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Ports Act, I, DANNY PHILIP, Minister of Commerce, Industries and Employment, do hereby make the following order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Ports (Declaration of Port Limits) (Port of Teterere) Order 1997.
2. The limits of the Port of Teterere are declared to be as specified in the Schedule.

## SCHEDULE

LR1014 is located in the Ghaobata Ward, Bolomona Council Area on Guadalcanal Island in Solomon Islands and located in the Teterere area and described herein.

The described area includes the water from the high water mark (HWM) and below the HWM and is located on the survey plans XK3358 and XK32/56.

All that are commencing at the southwest corner at an unpegged coordinated point HW1 and at grid bearing 360 degrees for a distance of 571.0 metres to an unpegged coordinated point RM10, thence 90 degrees 25 minutes 50 seconds for a distance of 452.07 metres to an unpegged coordinated point RM20, thence 180 degrees for a distance of 583.0 metres to an unpegged coordinated point HW4, thence along the HWM in the westerly direction to the point of origin HW1.

The area contained within the above described area is 193 hectares.

## THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE (DUTIES) (AMENDMENT)

(NO.8) ORDER 1997.

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Customs and Excise Act, I, MICHAEL MAINA, Minister of Finance, do hereby make the following order:

1. This order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Duties) (Amendment) (No.8) Order 1997 and shall come into force on the date of publication in the gazette.
2. That part of the First Schedule to the Customs and Excise Act entitled "IMPORT CLASSIFICATION AND TARIFF" is hereby amended in the following respects:-

- (i) by deleting the duty rates of 45% plus \$5000 which appears in respect of the following TariffItem Nos. 8702.1090, 8702.9090, 8703.2110, 8703.2311, 8703.2313, 8703.2393, 8703.2410, 8703.2430, 8703.3110, 8703.3210, 8703.3213, 8703.3310, 8703.3330, 8704.1010, 8704.2111, 8704.2121, 8704.2210, 8704.2310, 8704.3111, 8704.3121 and 8704.3210 and substituting therefore in each case 5% plus \$4,000.
