SOLOMON ISLANDS CORPORATION ELECTRONIC
MAIL (FACSIMILE TRANSMISSION) REGULATION 1998

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 42 of the Solomon Islands Postal Corporation Act 1996, the Minister hereby makes the following regulations -

1. These Regulation may be cited as the Solomon Islands Postal Corporation Electronic Mail (Facsimile Transmission) Regulation 1998.

TEMPORARY VARIATION WARRANT
