**THE PRICE CONTROL (APPLICATION TO GOODS
 AND RESTRICTION OF PRICES) (AMENDMENT)
 (No. 3) ORDER 1999.**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by sections 4 and 6 of the Price Control Act, and after consultations with the Prices Advisory Committee, I, DAVID HOLOSIVI, Minister of Indigenous Business Development, do hereby make the following Order -

1. This Order may be cited as the Price control (Application to Goods and Restriction of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1999 and shall come into operation on 19th November 1999.
2. Schedule 3 to the Price Control (Application to Goods and Restriction of Prices) Order 1987* is hereby amended by deleting serial No. 14 and substituting therefor the following -

"13 PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

	WHOLESALE (maximum price in cents per litre)	RETAIL (maximum price in cents per litre)
(a) Petroleum Motor Spirit (PMS)	157.47	206.1
(b) Distillate - (ADO)	136.53	182.0

(c) Kerosine - (KERO)	125.36	(maximum percentage mark-up)
		- Cost into store plus 15% for sales of packaged products.
		- Cost into store plus 20% for break-bulk sales."

THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT

(Cap. 121)

**THE RESTRICTED EXPORTS (AMENDMENT)
ORDER 1999.**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 35 of the Customs and Excise Act, I, ALPHA KIMATA, Minister of Finance, do hereby appoint make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Restricted Exports (Amendment) Order 1999 and shall come into force on the date of publication in the Gazette.

2. Paragraph 2 of the Third Schedule to the Customs and Excise Act is hereby amended by adding immediately after sub-paragraph (c) of that paragraph, the following new sub-paragraph as sub-paragraph (d) thereof -

“(d) Chlorofluorocarbons, Halons, other Fully Halogenated Chlorofluorocarbons, Methyl Bromide and any other Ozone Depleting Substances whether pure or in mixture form except under the authority of a licence issued by the Energy Division of the Department of Energy, Mines and Minerals.”

THE HONIARA CITY ACT 1999

THE HONIARA CITY ORDER 1999

(Section 72)

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 72 of the Honiara City Act 1999, I, REV. LESLIE BOSETO, Minister of Home Affairs, do hereby make the following Order -

1. This Order may be cited as the Honiara City Order, 1999.
2. Notwithstanding the coming into force of the Honiara City Act, 1999 -
 - (a) until such time as the City Council is constituted under the provisions of Part II, the Honiara Appointed council established by the Honiara Appointed Council Warrant 1998 shall continue to function for the purposes of performing administrative and other functions except the passing of laws.
 - (b) all seconded officers and other employees of the Honiara Town Council shall continue to be employed in their respective capacities and enjoy the same powers and privileges vested in them until such time as appointments are made pursuant to the Act, by the City Council to their respective posts.
 - (c) the messengers employed by the Town Council shall continue to perform their functions and exercise all powers vested in them pursuant to section 95 of the Local Government Act.
