**THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE (DUTIES)
(TARIFF ITEM NO. 1905.9090) ORDER 1999**

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 7 of the Customs and Excise Act, I, ALPHA KIMATA, Minister of Finance, do hereby make the following Order;

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Duties) Tariff Item No. 1905.9090) Order 1999
2. The rate of duty on biscuits falling within the terms of heading 1905.9090 in that part of the First Schedule to the Customs and Excise Act entitled "IMPORT CLASSIFICATION TARIFF", originated and imported from Papua New Guinea, Fiji and Vanuatu under the 1998 MSG TRADE AGREEMENT is hereby reduced from 40% to 0% (zero per cent)

**THE ELECTRICITY (HIGH VOLTAGE)
(TARIFF) (NORO) ORDER 1999**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 21 of the Electricity Act, the Minister, on the recommendation of the Authority, hereby makes the following Order;

1. This Order may be cited as the Electricity (High Voltage) (Tariff) (Noro) Order 1999.
2. This Order shall apply only to areas within the Noro Township.

3. The price to be charged for the supply of electricity for the area described in paragraph 2 above shall be as set out in the Schedule hereto:-

THE ELECTRICITY (TARIFF) (AMENDMENT) REGULATION 1999

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 21 and 55 of the Electricity Act, the Minister, on the recommendation of the Authority, hereby makes the following regulation:-

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Electricity (Tariff) (Amendment) Regulation 1999.
2. The Electricity (Tariff) Regulations are hereby amended by substituting for the Schedule thereto the following new Schedule:-

General and domestic Tariff for each Kilowatt hour	46.46 cents

General and all other Tariff (i.e. Industrial, Commercial, Government) for each Kilowatt hour	68.75 cents
