### THE SOLOMON ISLANDS INDEPENDENCE ORDER 1978

#### NOTICE TO MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 33(1) and Schedule 2 to the Constitution of Solomon Islands, I, SIR REV. JOHN INI LAPLI, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Solomon Islands, do hereby -

(1) Appoint 10:00am., the thirtieth day of June 2000, on the Australian Naval Ship HMAS Tobruk anchored offshore in Honiara as the time, date and place at which Members of Parliament shall meet for the purpose of electing a Prime Minister instead of being held at 9:00 am, (subsequently varied to 2:30 p.m.) the twenty-eighth day of June 2000, at the National Parliament as previously appointed; and

(2) Direct the Speaker of the National Parliament to make all necessary arrangements in connection with the aforesaid election meeting.

twenty-eighth day of June 2000.
