**APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER AND  
ACTING MINISTER FOR NATIONAL UNITY,  
RECONCILIATION AND PEACE**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by sections 33(3) and 37 of the Constitution, and acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, I, SIR, REV. JOHN INI LAPLI, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Solomon Islands, do hereby -

- (1) Appoint THE HONOURABLE WILLIAM HAOMAE to be Deputy Prime Minister; and
- (2) Assign to him the responsibility for National Unity, Reconciliation and Peace

with effect from the date hereof.
