**PRICE CONTROL ACT  
(Cap. 64)**

**THE PRICE CONTROL (APPLICATION TO GOODS AND  
RESTRICTION OF PRICES)  
(AMENDMENT) (NO. 6) ORDER 2003.**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by sections 4 and 6 of the Price

Control Act, and after consultations with the Prices Advisory Committee, I, TREVOR OLAVAE, Minister of Commerce, Employment and Trade, do hereby make the following Order -

1. This Order may be cited as the Price Control (Application to Goods and Restriction of Prices) (Amendment) (No.6) Order 2003 and shall come into operation on 4 August 2003.
2. Schedule 3 to the Price Control (Application to Goods and Restriction of Prices) Order 1987\* is hereby amended by deleting serial No.13 thereof and substituting therefor the following -

**“13 PETROLEUM PRODUCTS**
