**THE PHARMACY AND POISONS ACT  
(Cap. 105)**

**THE POISONS (AMENDMENT) RULES 2005**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 61 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Act, the Board, (with the approval of the Minister) hereby makes the following rules -

Citation  
1. These Rules may be cited as the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment) Rules 2005, and shall come into force on the date of publication in the Gazette.

Delete and substitution  
2. The Eleventh Schedule is hereby amended by deleting same and substituting therefor the following new Eleventh Schedule as follows -

“ELEVENTH SCHEDULE

(rule 27)

Scale of fees to be paid in respect  
of Registration, Licence, etc.

Licence to sell Part II Poisons \$100.00 pa

Licence to sell medicines  
(other than medicines in Schedule A to  
the Poisons List) \$200.00 pa

Poisons import permit  
(for each item on every occasion of  
importation) \$50.00 pa

Registration as a Pharmacist \$100.00 pa

Registration as a Pharmacy Assistant \$20.00 pa

Registration of Pharmacy Premises \$1,000.00 pa”.
