IN exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 116 (2) of the Constitution, the Public Service Commission delegates its powers set out in Column 1 of the Schedule to public officers mentioned in column 2 of that Schedule.

**SCHEDULE**

Power delegated [Column 1]	Public Officer [Column 2]
To exercise disciplinary control over officers holding or acting in SS3 to Level 7 (inclusive) positions.	Secretary to the Public Service
To exercise disciplinary control over officers holding or acting from Level 6 to Level 1 (inclusive) positions in the Ministry of Public Service.	
To exercise disciplinary control over officers holding or acting from Level 6 to Level 1 (inclusive) positions.	Permanent Secretary, Provincial Secretary, Clerk to Parliament, Auditor General, Attorney General and Private Secretary to the Governor General.
