THE MAGISTRATES COURT ACT (Cap. 20)

WARRANT EMPOWERING A MAGISTRATE TO HOLD PRINCIPAL MAGISTRATE'S COURT

UNDER Section 118 of the Constitution the Judicial and Legal Service Commission has appointed MEKEO GAULI to be a Principal Magistrate.

NOW THEREFORE under section 7 of the Magistrates Courts Act, I, SIR ALBERT R PALMER CBE give power under my hand and the seal of the High Court of Solomon Islands to **MEKEO GAULI** from 20 April 2009 to hold a Principal Magistrate's Court and to exercise all the powers and jurisdiction given by the Magistrates' Courts Act or any other Act to a Principal Magistrate.
